WHEREAS, after the receipt and examination of same, the County Purchasing Agent has now recommended to this Board that the lowest qualified bid, according to specifications, namely that of, ALL POINT MARINE SERVICES, be accepted

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, as follows:

1. The Director and Clerk of this Board are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract for furnishing and delivery of the Repowering and Upfitting of Two (2) 23' Pumpout Boats, for the County of Ocean, for the contract period from date of award until June 17, 2026, or until delivery is complete unless otherwise stated. The County reserves the right to extend the term of the contract pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-15.

A. ALL POINT MARINE SERVICES for two (2) items to wit:

Item Nos. 1 and 2.

For a Total Lump Sum Award (Item Nos. 1 - 2) of \$63,800.00.

2. Funds for the materials or services described herein shall be made available through operating and expense (O&E) accounts, trust accounts, grant accounts, or capital accounts maintained by, but not limited to, the following departments: Planning Board.

3. Payments for the materials to be acquired by these contracts shall be made upon the approval of vouchers submitted by the successful bidders in accordance with the requirements of the Board of Commissioners and subject to the Board of Commissioners customary procedures. Delivery shall be made upon receipt of a Purchase Order issued by the Ocean County Department of Purchase, upon which delivery locations and needed quantities shall be indicated.

4. The contract number must be placed on all papers, documents, invoices and vouchers pertaining to said contract, the number being B2025-87.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Resolution shall be made available to the County Auditor, Department of Purchasing, Department of Finance, Planning Board and All Points Marine Services, the successful bidder.

VENDOR REQUIREMENTS

The selected vendor must be able to receive and take delivery of any required parts, materials, and supplies needed to complete this work within four (4) months of receiving a formal purchase order from the County. Once the Ocean County Department of Planning delivers the specified vessel to the vendor, the vendor will have a maximum of one (1) month to complete the full installation and return the vessel as outlined in the scope of work.

If any portion of the work will be completed by a subcontractor, the vendor must identify the subcontractor in their bid submission. All subcontractors must be authorized dealers and/or certified installers for the original equipment manufacturer (OEM) whose parts or systems they are installing. Furthermore, subcontractors must agree to honor and service any OEM warranties for the equipment they supply. Proof of the subcontractor’s OEM certification must be included with the bid.

ITEM #1: REPOWERING TWO (2) 23’ PUMPOUT BOATS, AS SPECIFIED

The County requires the complete repowering of two (2) County-owned pumpout boats: the 2010 “Bay Sweeper” (HIN #UCF83091G910) and the 2014 “Bay Defender” (HIN #UCF83135A414). This includes full removal and proper disposal of the currently installed outboard engines and replacement with new units.

The vendor must provide and install the following components, which must meet or exceed the specifications listed below:
