WHEREAS, after the receipt and examination of same, the County Purchasing Agent has now recommended to this Board that the lowest qualified bid, according to specifications, in each instance, be accepted, namely, MPROTECTIVE, LLC.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, as follows:

1. The Director and Clerk of this Board are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract, for the Furnishing, Delivery and Installation of Weapons Detection System and Software No. II for the County of Ocean, for the contract shall be from date of award through December 17, 2025, or until delivery is complete unless otherwise stated. The County reserves the right to extend the term of the contract pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-15.

For a Total Lump Sum Award (Item Nos. 1 - 1A) of \$253,875.00

2. Payments for the materials to be acquired by these contracts shall be made upon the approval of vouchers submitted by the successful bidders in accordance with the requirements of the Board of Commissioners and subject to the Board of Commissioners customary procedures. Delivery shall be made upon receipt of a Purchase Order issued by the

Ocean County Department of Purchase, upon which delivery locations and needed quantities shall be indicated.

3. The Department of Finance has certified that funds are available in Account No. 419-010-X020 in the amount of \$253,875.00 to cover this contract, and the amount of this contract shall be encumbered against the said appropriations.

4. The contract number must be placed on all papers, documents, invoices and vouchers pertaining to said contract, the number being B2024-198.

Successful bidder shall provide in house 24/7/365 service and support and maintain an inventory of spare parts, to include the availability of in house Evolv loaner systems that deliver the following, at minimum:

- Detection Capability: Must detect a wide range of weapons and threats while minimizing false alarms.
- Efficient Entry: Enables natural walking pace screening for swift throughput.
- Consistent Detection: AI-powered sensors distinguish between concealed threats and benign items.
- Red Box Identification: Displays potential threat locations on the Evolv tablet, enhancing operational speed and accuracy.
