County of Ocean Request for Qualifications

Professional Engineering Services for Underground Storage Tanks Responses Due: Tuesday, January 12, 2020

INTRODUCTION

The County of Ocean is a County of Fifth Class as defined in N.J.S.A. 40A:6-1 et seq. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4 et seq., the County of Ocean requests qualifications from vendors capable of providing professional engineering services for underground storage tanks for a one year contract term.

The successful vendor(s) must have a minimum of ten (10) years experience in providing these services.

SCOPE OF WORK

- A. Underground Storage Tank Services:
 - 1. Provide a qualified Professional Engineer who is thoroughly knowledgeable with underground and aboveground tanks, piping, sensors, monitors, and dispenser systems. This includes spill and overfill prevention, release detection, product and equipment compatibility, corrosion protection, vapor recovery, record keeping, NJDEP permits and notification requirements, underground storage tank (UST) upgrading and closure.
 - 2. With experience in UST design, operational, and maintenance requirements, in accordance with New Jersey Administrative Code and 40 CFR 280, and 40 CFR 112.
 - 3. Capable of providing guidance about regulatory requirements, including permitting, design, operation, closure plans and remediation and possesses communication and coordination skills required to assist with design, bid, and construction phases

The engineer will perform the following tasks:

- 4. Recommend courses of action to the County regarding regulatory requirements of the NJDEP, including permitting, design, operation,
- 5. Provide bid specifications, drawings and documents necessary to close UST sites, upgrade UST sites, install ASTs, identify/resolve issues pertaining to NJDEP regulatory requirements
- 6. In conjunction with the County Engineer, coordinate shop drawing reviews.
- 7. Consult with the County Engineer if any Contractor requests interpretations of the meaning and intent of the drawings and specifications and assist in the resolution of questions which may arise.
- 8. Assist the County Engineer in preparing a punchlist of incomplete or unsatisfactory items pertaining to USTs

B. Site Remediation Services:

1. Provide qualified Licensed Site Remediation Professionals (LSRP) who have in-depth understanding of Site Remediation Reform Act (SRRA) and the issues associated with petroleum contaminated sites. The LSRP must possess communication and coordination skills required to effectively carry out the responsibilities of interacting with the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP).

The LSRP will perform the following tasks:

- 2. Perform preliminary assessments/site investigations
- 3. Oversee well installation and decommissioning
- 4. Provide remedial groundwater investigations providing potential alternative sampling methodologies for horizontal and vertical delineation.
- 5. Recommend compliance with administrative and technical requirements for the remediation of contaminated sites
- 6. Provide cost estimates of projected future remediation
- 7. Monitor, report and remediate contaminated sites at the Ship Bottom, Lakewood and Jackson road garages.
- 8. Develop Response Action Outcomes and associated outcomes leading to a No Further Action/Response Action Outcome letter
- 9. Provide potential oversight of emergency response and cleanup efforts, ecological evaluation and human health concerns
- 10. In conjunction with County staff, recommend courses of action when requirements of the NJDEP are not being fulfilled

ALL SUBMISSIONS MUST INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING MINIMUM INFORMATION:

- 1. Name of the individual(s) to be assigned to perform the tasks. Experience of the individual(s) to be assigned including a listing of experience with the County of Ocean and/or experience with New Jersey.
 - a. The Professional Engineer must have minimum of 10 years UST experience.
 - b. The Licensed Site Remediation Professional (LSRP) must have a minimum of 10 years remediation experience.
- 2. A statement concerning the ability of the vendor to perform tasks assigned by the County in a timely fashion.

- 3. A description of the support staff available to the individual(s) to be assigned.
- 4. A signed, completed copy of the enclosed RFQ Document Checklist and documents required therein.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

All responses to the Request for Qualifications ("RFQ"):

- 1. Will be opened publicly in the Administration Building, Room 335, 101 Hooper Avenue, Toms River, New Jersey, commencing at 4:00 p.m., prevailing time, on **Tuesday, January 12, 2020.**
- 2. Must be enclosed in a **sealed envelope** bearing the **name and address of the submitter, the name of this RFQ and the RFQ date on the outside of the envelope**. All proposals should be stapled in the upper left corner, no plastic binding shall be accepted.
- 3. Responses which are to be hand delivered the day of the opening must be taken and presented to the Ocean County Administrator at the time the responses to this RFQ are called for.

- 5. The County will not be responsible for late mail deliveries and no responses to this RFQ will be accepted by the County if received after the time stipulated above.
- 6. All proposals must be enclosed in one (1) sealed package. The package shall include an original and two (2) copies of the Technical Proposal and a sealed envelope containing an original and one (1) copy of the Fee Schedule of Direct Labor Hourly Rates, Overhead, Profit, and Direct Expenses, identified and bearing the name and address of the proposer, the name of the proposal and the date of the opening on the outside of the envelopes. Documents should be paper, double-sided and stapled in the upper left corner. No plastic will be accepted. Failure to comply with this provision will be cause for rejection.

SELECTION CRITERIA

The Ocean County Engineer shall designate a committee to review and rank all responses. The selection criteria to be used in awarding a contract for the services described herein, shall include:

- 1. Qualifications of the individuals who will perform the tasks and the amounts of their respective participation; experience with New Jersey.
 - a. The Professional Engineer must have a minimum of 10 years UST experience.
 - b. The LSRP must have a minimum of 10 remediation experience.
- 2. Experience in providing the services requested by the County and references related thereto; experience with New Jersey.
 - a. Provide a summary of various UST projects performed over the last 5 years. Include summaries such as design of piping, sensors, monitors, dispenser systems, corrosion protection, vapor recovery, UST upgrading, UST closure plans, and analysis of product and equipment compatibility.
 - b. Provide a summary of environmental projects performed over the last 5 years. Include descriptions of preliminary site investigations and assessments, remedial groundwater investigations, technical compliance administration for the remediation of contaminated sites, estimates of projected future remediation costs, and resolution of issues associated with petroleum contaminated sites.
- 3. Ability to perform the tasks in a timely fashion, including staffing and familiarity with the subject matter and the County;
- 4. Location (distance) of primary office in relation to the County administrative offices;
- 5. Recent, current and projected work load of the vendor;
- 6. Thoroughness and completeness of the applicant's submittal.

^{*} Failure to complete these required documents will be cause for rejection

Ranking

Proposal Evaluation: All proposals will be reviewed to determine if they are responsive. A committee, using the criteria set forth herein, will then evaluate responsive proposals.

40% Responsiveness to the Request for Qualifications 60% Experience and Knowledge of the Firm and Team Members

- 1. Responsiveness to the Request for Qualifications includes:
 - 1) Demonstrating thorough understanding of the project requirements
 - 2) Technical quality of the proposal
 - 3) Proximity to the County seat
 - 4) Completeness of the proposal
- 2. Experience and Knowledge of the Firm and Team Members includes:
 - 1) Details of similar and recent projects
 - 2) Project team organization
 - 3) Knowledge of Ocean County and other applicable Public Agency requirements (NJDEP)
 - 4) Qualifications of the designated key personnel
 - 5) Experience of the designated key personnel
 - 6) Reference recommendations of the designated key personnel

All proposals will be reviewed for completeness and qualifications.

All complete and qualified proposals will be ranked in accordance with the evaluation criteria.

The County of Ocean shall award a contract to the vendor or vendors that best meet the needs and interests of Ocean County. The County reserves the right to negotiate the terms and conditions of a contract with the successful vendor or vendors to obtain the most cost advantageous services for the County.

The County intends to recommend at least two (2) qualified firms to perform Professional Engineering Services for Underground Storage Tanks.

A Purchase Order/Contract will be issued for the specific assignment based upon the submitted quote that is in the best interest of the County determined by the County Engineer at the firm's contract rates. Fees will be paid for on the basis of actual hours worked and not to exceed a defined amount per assignment.

The County reserves the right to reject any or all proposals in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:11-13.2, or to waive any informalities and non-material defects in the proposals and to accept any proposal deemed in the best interest of the County.

Indemnity Clause - The bidder, if awarded a contract, agrees to protect, defend and save harmless the County against any damage for payment for the use of any patented material process, article or device that may enter into the manufacture, construction or form a part of the work covered by either order or contract, and he further agrees to indemnify and save harmless the County from suits or actions of every nature and description brought against it, for, or on account of injuries or damages received or sustained by any party or parties by, or from any of the negligent acts of the contractor, his servants or agents.

Insurance - The contractor shall maintain primary insurance to protect against all claims under Worker's Compensation, Comprehensive General Liability and Automobile. The coverage shall apply as primary coverage with respect to any other insurance or self-insurance program afforded to the County. There shall be no endorsement or modification of this coverage to make it excess over other available insurance/coverage; alternatively, if the CGL and umbrella, excess of reinsurance states that it is pro rata, it shall be endorsed to be primary with respect to the County. Primary coverage shall be subject to approval for adequacy of protection as per the following limits:

Worker's Compensation

- 1. Limits according to Worker's compensation Laws of the State of New Jersey.
- 2. Contractor's Liability not less than \$100,000.

Comprehensive General Liability

- 1. Bodily Injury \$500,000 per person; \$1,000,000 per occurrence.
- 2. Property Damage \$1,000,000 per occurrence.

Comprehensive General Liability shall include the following:

- 1. Coverage for explosion, collapse or underground hazards.
- 2. Occurrence basis coverage.
- 3. Broad form property damage coverage.
- 4. Coverage for personal injury sustained by any person as a result of an offense directly or indirectly related to the employment of such person by the insured.

Comprehensive Automobile Liability shall include the following:

Business auto liability insurance or its equivalent with a minimum limit of \$1,000,000 per accident and including coverage for all of the following:

Liability arising out of the ownership, maintenance or use of any auto;

Auto non-ownership and hired car coverage.

Contractor's Worker's Compensation, Comprehensive General Liability and Comprehensive Automobile Liability arising out of subcontractor's operations shall be identical as that listed above.

Copies of each insurance certificate shall be furnished to the County with Proposal and must state the County of Ocean is additionally insured.

It is to be understood by the proposer that their proposal is submitted on the basis of specifications prepared by the County and the fact that any proposer is not familiar with these specifications or conditions will not be accepted as an excuse.

Payments will be made upon the approval of vouchers submitted by the successful proposer in accordance with the requirements of the Board of Chosen Freeholders and subject to the Board of Freeholders customary procedures. The County will not pay interest or late fees regardless of language provided.

Ocean County Board of Chosen Freeholders will make award within sixty (60) days after receipt of proposals.

The County of Ocean is exempt from any State sales tax or Federal excise tax.

"All contractors must comply with the provisions of New Jersey Statute Title 40A:11-18, when applicable."

Starting in January 2007, all business entities are advised of their responsibility to file an annual disclosure statement of political contributions with the New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission (ELEC) pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.27 if they receive contracts in excess of \$50,000 from public entities in a calendar year. Business entities are responsible for determining if filing is necessary. Additional information on this requirement is available from ELEC at 888-313-3532 or at www.elec.state.nj.us.

Certification of Non-Involvement in Prohibited Activities in Iran. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:32-58, the proposer must certify that neither the proposer, nor one of its parents, subsidiaries, and/or affiliates (as defined in N.J.S.A. 52:32-56€(3)), is listed on the Department of the Treasury's List of Persons or Entities Engaging in Prohibited Investment Activities in Iran and that neither is involved in any of the investment activities set forth in N.J.S.A. 52:32-56(f). If the proposer is unable to so certify, the proposer shall provide a detailed and precise description of such activities.

Transitional Period (excluding Professional Contracts) – In the event services are terminated by contract expiration or by voluntary termination by either the Contractor or the County of Ocean, the Contractor shall continue all terms and conditions of said contract for a period not to exceed one month, at the County's request.

New Jersey Business Registration Requirements. Pursuant to <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 52:32-44, Ocean County ("Contracting Agency") is prohibited from entering into a contract with an entity unless the bidder/proposer/contractor, and each subcontractor that is required by law to be named in a bid/proposal/contract has a valid Business Registration Certificate on file with the Division of Revenue and Enterprise Services within the Department of the Treasury.

Prior to contract award or authorization, the contractor shall provide the Contracting Agency with its proof of business registration and that of any named subcontractor(s).

Subcontractors named in a bid or other proposal shall provide proof of business registration to the bidder, who in turn, shall provide it to the Contracting Agency prior to the time a contract, purchase order, or other contracting document is awarded or authorized.

During the course of contract performance:

1. The contractor shall not enter into a contract with a subcontractor unless the subcontractor first provides the contractor with a valid proof of business registration.

- 2. The contractor shall maintain and submit to the Contracting Agency a list of subcontractors and their addresses that may be updated from time to time.
- 3. The contractor and any subcontractor providing goods or performing services under the contract, and each of their affiliates, shall collect and remit to the Director of the Division of Taxation in the Department of the Treasury, the use tax due pursuant to the Sales and Use Tax Act, (N.J.S.A. 54:32B-1 et seq.) on all sales of tangible personal property delivered into the State. Before final payment is made under the contract, the contractor shall submit to the Contracting Agency a complete and accurate list of all subcontractors used and their addresses.

Pursuant to <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 54:49-4.1, a business organization that fails to provide a copy of a business registration as required, or that provides false business registration information, shall be liable for a penalty of \$25 for each day of violation, not to exceed \$50,000, for each proof of business registration not properly provided under a contract with a contracting agency.



GOODS, PROFESSIONAL SERVICE AND GENERAL SERVICE CONTRACTS

During the performance of this contract, the contractor agrees as follows:

The contractor or subcontractor, where applicable, will not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of age, race, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status, affectional or sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, disability, nationality or sex. Except with respect to affectional or sexual orientation and gender identity or expression, the contractor will ensure that equal employment opportunity is afforded to such applicants in recruitment and employment, and that employees are treated during employment, without regard to their age, race, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status, affectional or sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, disability, nationality or sex. Such equal employment opportunity shall include, but not be limited to the following: employment, upgrading, demotion, or transfer; recruitment or recruitment advertising; layoff or termination; rates of pay or other forms of compensation; and selection for training, including apprenticeship. The contractor agrees to post in conspicuous places, available to employees and applicants for employment, notices to be provided by the Public Agency Compliance Officer setting forth provisions of this nondiscrimination clause.

The contractor or subcontractor, where applicable will, in all solicitations or advertisements for employees placed by or on behalf of the contractor, state that all qualified applicants will receive consideration for employment without regard to age, race, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status, affectional or sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, disability, nationality or sex.

The contractor or subcontractor will send to each labor union, with which it has a collective bargaining agreement, a notice, to be provided by the agency contracting officer, advising the labor union of the contractor's commitments under this chapter and shall post copies of the notice in conspicuous places available to employees and applicants for employment.

The contractor or subcontractor, where applicable, agrees to comply with any regulations promulgated by the Treasurer pursuant to N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq., as amended and supplemented from time to time and the Americans with Disabilities Act.

The contractor or subcontractor agrees to make good faith efforts to meet targeted county employment goals established in accordance with N.J.A.C. 17:27-5.2.

The contractor or subcontractor agrees to inform in writing its appropriate recruitment agencies including, but not limited to, employment agencies, placement bureaus, colleges, universities, and labor unions, that it does not discriminate on the basis of age, race, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status, affectional or sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, disability, nationality or sex, and that it will discontinue the use of any recruitment agency which engages in direct or indirect discriminatory practices.
