WHEREAS, on December 2, 2025 pursuant to legal advertisements therefor, sealed bids were received for the furnishing and delivery of EXTRADITION SERVICES NO. II for the County of Ocean; and

WHEREAS, after the receipt and examination of the same, the County Purchasing Agent has now recommended to this Board that both bids received be rejected as unresponsive. Recommendation is made to authorize the County Purchasing Agent to enter into negotiated contracts in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A: 11-5(3), as no responsive bids were received for a second time.

WHEREAS N.J.S.A. 40A: 11-5(3) provides that, in the event no qualified bids are received on two occasions, a governing body may enter into a negotiable contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, as follows:

1. The County Purchasing Agent is hereby authorized and directed to enter into negotiations leading to the furnishing and delivery of Extradition Services No. II for Item No. 1, for the contract period of one (1) year from December 17, 2025 through December 16, 2026, or until delivery is complete unless otherwise stated. The County reserves the right to extend the term of the contract pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-15.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Resolution shall be made available to the County Auditor, Purchasing Department, Finance Department and the Sheriff's Office.
