December 6, 2023

WHEREAS, the County of Ocean has funds available for Child and Adolescent Trauma Programming which would facilitate training, consultation, and start-up associated with grief support groups and grief interventions for children and adolescents; and

WHEREAS, on December 7, 2022, the Ocean County Board of Commissioners adopted a resolution authorizing the use of competitive contracting for the procurement of Child and Adolescent Trauma Programming; and

WHEREAS, Competitive Contracting Procedures have been followed in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:11-4.3 for the services listed above; and

WHEREAS, on May 3, 2023 the Ocean County Board of Commissioners awarded an Agreement to Bright Harbor Healthcare, 687 Route 9, Bayville, New Jersey 08721 to provide such services, for May 1, 2023 through December 31, 2023, not to exceed \$75,000.00, as more specifically set forth in the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, on October 18, 2023, an amendatory agreement was executed to correct the service term and specifically delineate the requisite minimum insurance coverages; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement was for an 8 month period and, at the successful completion, two (2) one-year extensions can be exercised; and

WHEREAS, the Ocean County Department of Human Services desires to utilize the option to extend the Agreement for January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2024; and

WHEREAS, funds up to the total amount of \$75,000.00 will be appropriated for these services, as follows:

Fund Account <u>Amount</u> ARPA- Child & Adolescent Trauma 021-205-AR06 \$75,000.00

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, OF THE COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, as follows:

1) The Director and Clerk of the Board are hereby authorized to enter into and execute an Agreement with Bright Harbor Healthcare for the period of January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2024, to provide Child and Adolescent Trauma Programming, contingent upon the availability of funds.

- 3) The Director and Clerk of the Board are hereby authorized and directed to execute any necessary subsequent and related documents.
- 4) A certified copy of this Resolution, together with a copy of the Agreement executed by the parties, shall remain on file and be available for public inspection at the office of the Clerk of the Board of Commissioners.
