

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Ocean County will receive bids 11:00 a.m. Tuesday, **May 6, 2025** in the Administration Building, Toms River, NJ for **Stormwater Management Improvements Contract 2024A, Various Townships**. Plans and specs are available on the County's OpenGov Electronic Bid Portal (<https://procurement.opengov.com/portal/oceancounty>). Bidders must comply with P.L. 1975, C. 127 and 10% Surety required. The work to be performed under this Contract consists of the installation of approximately 1,700 linear feet of Cured-In-Place Pipe (CIPP), varying in sizes of 12", 18", 24", 36", and 60", across various locations in Beachwood Borough, Brick Township, Jackson Township, South Toms River Borough, and Toms River Township. The installation will be carried out using a hot water or steam curing process and will include all necessary tasks such as traffic control, bypass pumping, and clearing of the existing storm sewer lines and drains to ensure proper conditions for the CIPP installation, meeting all required standards.

Estimated construction cost range: \$1,000,000.00 to \$5,000,000.00
