Program Narrative

Ocean County has entered into a Competitive Contract with CFG Health Systems, LLC to provide Health Care Services for the Ocean County Department of Corrections for the contract year beginning September 1, 2021 through August 31, 2024. Currently, this contract is in the first year of the exercised extension expiring August 31, 2025. In order to ensure that all services are rendered in accordance with this contract, and that all inmates at the Ocean County Jail are provided health care services in complete compliance with all applicable state and federal standards, the County desires to obtain the services of a qualified contract monitor. It is the intent of this bid to secure an independent contract monitor specializing in correctional healthcare services, capable of monitoring all aspects of healthcare and will ensure the delivery of a high quality healthcare system for all adult inmates. It is also our intent to secure a monitor that will work jointly with the medical contractor, and to promote a working partnership between County Management, Jail Administrators and the medical contractor.
