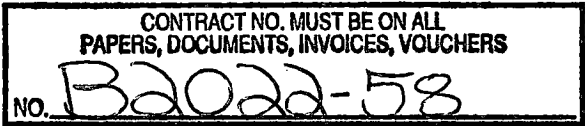

WHEREAS, after the receipt and examination of same, the County Purchasing Agent has now recommended to this Board that the lowest qualified bid, according to specifications, namely that of, COMMERCIAL LUBRICANTS MOOVE CORP. be accepted. No bids were received for Item No. 45. The Purchasing Agent is given the authority to enter into a negotiated contract pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(3) for no bid item No. 45.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY.

1. The Director and Clerk of this Board are hereby authorized and directed to enter into contracts for the furnishing and delivery of Antifreeze, Oils and Lubricants No. II for the County of Ocean, for the contract period from date of award through March 15, 2023, or until delivery is complete. The County reserves the right to extend the term of the contract pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-15 as follows:

COMMERCIAL LUBRICANTS MOOVE CORP for twenty eight (28) items, to wit:
ITEMS NO. 1, 2, 3, 19, 20 and 32.

This vendor has extended this contract to County Cooperative Contract System Participants.

2. The acceptance made in Paragraph 1, is made with the understanding that the successful bidder(s) will enter into a written contract for the faithful performance of their bid to supply Antifreeze, Oils and Lubricants No. II in Ocean County during the contract period.

3. Payments for the materials to be acquired by these contracts shall be made upon the approval of vouchers submitted by the successful bidders in accordance with the requirements of the Board of Commissioners and subject to the Board of Commissioners customary procedures. Delivery shall be made upon receipt of a Purchase Order issued by the Ocean County Department of Purchase, upon which delivery locations and needed quantities shall be indicated.

4. The contract number must be placed on all papers, documents, invoices and vouchers pertaining to said contract, the number being B2022-58.

5. **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that certified copies of this Resolution shall be made available to the County Auditor, Department of Purchasing, Department of Finance, Vehicle Services, and the successful bidder.
