## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on September 4, 2024, pursuant to legal advertisements therefor, sealed bids were received for the furnishing and delivery of UNPAINTED SNOW FENCE AND DUNE GRASS NO. II for the County of Ocean; and

WHEREAS, at the advertised time, one bid was received from the following bidder:

WHEREAS, after the receipt and examination of same, the County Purchasing Agent has now recommended to this Board that the sole qualified bid, according to specifications, namely that of, CHURCH'S GARDEN CENTER & FARMS, INC., be accepted.

NOW. THEREFORE. BE IT RESOLVED by the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, as follows:

1. The Director and Clerk of this Board are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract accepting the bid for the furnishing and delivery of Unpainted Snow Fence and Dune Grass No. II, for the County of Ocean, for the contract period from date of award until August 20, 2025, or until delivery is complete unless otherwise stated. The County reserves the right to extend the term of the contract, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-15.

2. Delivery shall be made upon receipt of a Purchase Order issued by the Ocean County Department of Purchase, upon which delivery locations and needed quantities shall be indicated.

The Hudsonia tomentosa (Woolley Beach Heather) is an extremely scarce and rare plant. We would like to supply an alternate plant that we feel would help to stabilize the sand while adding some distinct beauty and benefits to the dune system.

Our alternate suggestion would be Schizachyrium scoparium (Little Bluestem) grown in plastic trays of 72 plants per tray. These would be easy to keep watered and transported to each planting destination as they can be included with the normal beachgrass allocations. Our suggestion would be to start this year with 10-20,000 plants, divide them up to each municipality and monitor their growth and success.

Little Bluestern has beautiful foliage consisting of greens, blues or purples turning to oranges and reds in the fall. Schizachyrium scoparium produces downy white seeds in September providing a stunning contrast to it's fall color. This native grass grows upright approximately 2-3 ft. and provides great cover for birds seeking protection from predators and the elements.
